Method of Study

- Take each portion of the Low View of God and the Proper View of God.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to examine your view of God in relation to the topic.
- Study the Scriptures to get more insight and depth into how God has revealed Himself in Scriptures.
- Have a Strong's Concordance (online or book form) to understand some of the words for their original meaning.
- Use a word-for-word translation that is true and most accurate to the Original Texts. (*King James Version*)
- Apply what God teaches you by His Spirit through the word, meditating on the truths and with thanksgiving.
- Never be content with what you know, learn to use it for your daily growth and application.

Questions to Ask in your daily reading of the Scriptures

- What does it say about the attributes of God?
 - o How He deals with His children, Divine Providence, His justice, His judgement, His enemies, His dealings with mankind, His Love, His desire for creation.
- How does that reflect on the revelation of Christ?
- How does the life of Christ tie back to the Old Testament and its revelation of God?
